



# Student Inpatient Diagnostic Evaluation

SERVICES AVAILABLE for students ages 4 to 17

- **INPATIENT ASSESSMENT**

Children and adolescents in school can be evaluated for mental and behavioral health concerns and interventions

- **DIAGNOSTIC OVERVIEW**

Intensive review of child or adolescent's functioning in school and other group settings

- **AFTERCARE PLAN**

Recommendations for the best course of treatment for the child or adolescent, including risk assessment

- **EXIT CONFERENCE AND WRITTEN REPORT**

Prior to discharge, an exit conference in person or by telephone will be held; a written report will be provided within one week of discharge

## Diagnostic Evaluation Component Options

Diagnostic evaluations are tailored to meet the needs of individual schools and districts.

Evaluation reports can include the following:

- Comprehensive psychiatric evaluation
- Comprehensive social and family history
- History and physical
- Nursing assessment
- Pharmacological intervention assessment
- Psychological testing
- Dietary assessment
- Educational testing and evaluation
- Structured groups and activities emphasizing coping skill development
- Referring school consultation
- Chemical dependency assessment
